All Courses Use the King James Version (KJV) Only

All courses at King James Bible College are taught exclusively from the King James Version (KJV) of the Bible — **not** the NKJV or any other translation. Our college stands firmly as **King James Only**, and every course, program, and quiz is based solely on the KJV. Please note that any quiz answers given using another version will be marked incorrect.

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1. History & Purpose

King James Bible College is a ministry of King James Bible Ministries, established with the mission of equipping believers with a solid foundation in God's Word, using only the **King James Version** of the Holy Scriptures. We believe that the Word of God should be taught freely to all who hunger and thirst after righteousness.

As the Lord said, "*Freely ye have received, freely give*" (Matthew 10:8). The Apostle Paul declared, "*For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!*" (1 Corinthians 9:16).

In March of 2025, the Board of King James Bible Ministries voted to make **all programs completely free of charge**, so that cost will never be a barrier for anyone seeking to gain more knowledge of the Word of God and to earn their degree.

We operate entirely by faith, depending on the Lord to meet our needs through the generosity of His people. We seek ongoing support from individuals and churches to help us continue offering free Bible education around the world.

2. Admissions

Enrollment at King James Bible College is simple and open to all believers who desire to grow in their knowledge of God's Word.

To enroll online:

- I. Register for an account on our website.
- II. Click on the course you would like to start.
- III. Begin the course. You are officially registered once you start.

To enroll in mail correspondence (U.S. only):

- I. Submit the registration form located on the "Mail Correspondence" page.

II. Your first lessons will be mailed to you after processing.

Once the required courses for your chosen program are completed, your degree or certificate will be issued.

3. Application Process

Our application process follows the same steps as admissions. There are no application fees, no transcripts required, and no academic prerequisites other than a desire to study God's Word. At this time, **we do not accept any transfer credits** from other institutions.

4. International Students

We welcome students worldwide for our online programs. However, mail correspondence courses are currently only available within the United States. **Through partnerships with select international churches and agencies, students in certain regions outside the U.S. may also complete their studies locally using our Mail Correspondence and Assessment-Only programs. These opportunities are limited and available only in specific areas.**

5. Enrollment Periods

Since we are 100% online and also offer mail correspondence, students may begin their studies at any time.

From time to time, we will offer online Zoom courses, which will be announced on our website.

Courses taught in partner "Hub" churches will have specific enrollment periods that will also be announced online when available.

6. Programs Offered

King James Bible College offers flexible study options designed to fit each student's needs and learning preferences. All programs are taught exclusively from the **King James Version (KJV)** of the Bible. Students may choose from the following programs — or combine them as they work toward their **Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies** or Certificate programs. (NOTE: All programs counts towards your BA Degree)

A. Online Courses

Our **Online Courses** allow students to complete their studies from anywhere with internet access.

Each course includes video lectures from our instructors, reading assignments, and quizzes that are graded instantly through our online system (with exception for some assignments). This provides a convenient and interactive learning experience.

B. Mail Correspondence Program

Our **Mail Correspondence Program** offers the same courses as our online option, designed for those who prefer printed materials or may not have regular internet access.

Students receive their lessons by mail, complete their coursework, and return it for grading. Upon grading, the next lesson is mailed out.

This program provides a structured, self-paced approach similar to our online courses—just without the video lectures or instant grading features.

C. Assessment-Only Program

The **Assessment-Only Program** is ideal for students who have prior biblical knowledge or experience and wish to demonstrate their understanding without taking full course lessons.

Assessments can be completed **online, by mail, or through email**.

Students who successfully pass the required assessments will receive full course credit toward their **Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies**.

This flexible option allows students to progress at their own pace while still fulfilling the academic requirements of the degree program. To successfully complete a course in the Assessment-Only Program, students must earn a minimum grade of **80% or higher**.

Students are permitted **two attempts** to pass each course assessment. If both attempts result in a failing grade, the student will be required to complete that specific course through one of the other available programs, such as the **Online or Mail Correspondence** program.

D. Standalone Courses

Our **Standalone Courses** provide an excellent opportunity for anyone desiring to study God's Word without enrolling in a full program. These courses are the same ones required for the **Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies**, but students may choose any individual course of interest, even if they are not pursuing a certificate or degree.

Upon completion, students will receive a **digital certificate of completion** for each course taken. If they later decide to enroll in the full degree program, all completed Standalone Courses can be applied toward their degree requirements.

Program Flexibility

Students are welcome to **mix and match** program formats. For example, you may complete some courses online, others through mail correspondence, and others via the assessment-only method.

All programs lead toward the same recognized degree or certificate, allowing each student to study God's Word in the way that best fits their life and calling.

Degree Programs

1. Bachelors in Biblical Studies

- A 120-credit-hour program consisting of 48 courses, each worth 2.5 credit hours, covering a broad study of the

entire Bible. Available online or through mail correspondence (mail option available only in the U.S.).

This foundational 120-credit-hour program covers the entirety of God's inspired Word, the King James Bible. Students will study the Old and New Testaments, key doctrines, biblical history, and Christian living. The program is designed to build a solid scriptural foundation for personal growth and ministry. Available online and via mail correspondence (U.S. only).

2. Master of Biblical Studies

- Requires completion of the Bachelors in Biblical Studies. Includes 45 additional credit hours focused on deeper, more concentrated biblical study, critical analysis, and ministry application.

An advanced 45-credit-hour program requiring completion of the Bachelors degree. This course provides deeper study in biblical interpretation, theology, ministry applications, and critical analysis of Scripture. Students are prepared for more specialized ministry roles and advanced theological understanding.

Certificate Programs

(All available online or through hybrid courses at local partner churches)

- **Certificate in Old Testament Studies**
- **Certificate in New Testament Studies**
- **Certificate in King James Bible Studies**

Certificate Program Descriptions

Certificate in Old Testament Studies

Focuses on the history, themes, and theology of the Old Testament

books, exploring God's covenant with Israel and His unfolding plan of redemption.

Certificate in New Testament Studies

Covers the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, the early church, and apostolic writings, emphasizing the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy and the foundation of Christian doctrine.

Certificate in King James Bible Studies

Explores the history, translation, preservation, and unique qualities of the King James Version, reinforcing its authority and reliability as God's preserved Word.

Certificate in Biblical Textual Studies

Teaches the fundamentals of biblical manuscripts, textual criticism, and how the Scriptures have been accurately preserved through history.

Certificate in Biblical History and Preservation

Studies the historical context of the Bible, archaeology, and how the Scriptures have been maintained and transmitted across generations.

Certificate in Biblical Discipleship Training

Equips students with practical skills for discipleship, evangelism, and spiritual growth, following the example of Christ and the apostles.

Bible Teaching Certificate

Designed for those called to teach, this program provides training in biblical exposition, sermon preparation, and effective teaching methods grounded in Scripture.

7. Tuition & Fees

There are **no tuition costs or fees** for any of our programs. In March 2025, our Board voted to make all programs free so that financial limitations will never prevent anyone from studying God's Word.

We operate entirely by donations from individuals and churches who believe in our mission.

8. Accreditation

At **King James Bible College**, we firmly believe that the **Word of God** is the ultimate source of truth and authority in all matters—including education. As the Bible declares in **2 Timothy 3:16 (KJV)**, “*All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.*”

Our curriculum is deeply rooted in biblical principles. Our foremost commitment is to ensure that every course and program we offer is grounded in Scripture and led by the Holy Spirit—not dictated by secular systems or worldly standards.

So, is our college accredited? A more fitting question might be, “*Is King James Bible College accredited by man’s law?*” The answer is **no**. We stand firmly on the sufficiency of God’s Word and believe that our ultimate accountability is to Him, as written in **Acts 5:29 (KJV)**: “*We ought to obey God rather than men.*”


While secular accreditation has its place in the academic world, our priority is to uphold **God’s standards** above all earthly requirements. That said, we recognize that some students and ministries value formal accreditation, and we are currently **exploring accreditation options** through **faith-based organizations** that specialize in theological education.

These Christian accrediting bodies assess the quality and integrity of biblical institutions, ensuring that they meet high academic and spiritual standards while remaining faithful to sound doctrine. We are prayerfully working toward securing this type of **biblically aligned accreditation** in the near future.

It is important to understand that theological studies fall **outside the jurisdiction of the U.S. Department of Education (US-DOE)**. Therefore, no accrediting body for theological education operates under US-DOE authority. Our goal is to partner only with organizations that recognize the unique nature of biblical education and are committed to preserving its integrity.

At **King James Bible College**, our mission remains unwavering—to provide a quality education that honors and upholds the teachings of Scripture while striving for excellence in biblical instruction.

Accreditation may be one part of that process, but our foundation will **always and forever be the Word of God.**



9. Grading Information

At **King James Bible College**, we believe that academic excellence should reflect our commitment to honoring the Lord in all we do (Colossians 3:23). Each student is encouraged to study diligently, as faithful stewardship of God's Word is central to spiritual growth and ministry preparation.

Grading Scale

All courses are graded on the following standard scale:

Percentage	Grade	Description
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100–90%	A	Excellent
89–80%	B	Good
79–70%	C	Satisfactory
69% and below	D	Failing

A **minimum passing grade of 70%** is required for all standard courses. However, for the **Assessment-Only Program**, a higher passing grade of **80% or above** is required in each course.

Grading Procedures

- **Online Courses:** Quizzes and assignments are graded automatically through our online system, providing students with immediate feedback. (Some assignments may require instructor grading, please allow 24-72 business hours for these)

- **Mail Correspondence Courses:** Grades are recorded once the completed lessons are received, reviewed, and entered by the instructor. (Please allow up to a 2 week turn around)
- **Assessment-Only Program:** Students are permitted two attempts per course assessment. If both attempts result in a failing grade, the student must complete that course through one of the other programs (Online or Mail Correspondence). (Please allow up to a 2 week turn around)

Course Completion and Grade Records

Upon completion of each course, final grades are recorded in the student's academic file. Students may request a transcript of completed coursework at any time. Grades contribute toward the student's overall **Grade Point Average (GPA)** and progress toward their **Certificate** or **Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies** degree.

Commitment to Academic Integrity

All students are expected to complete their own work honestly and in accordance with biblical principles. Any form of academic dishonesty—including plagiarism, the use of **artificial intelligence (AI) tools** to generate or complete assignments, or unauthorized assistance on quizzes—will result in review and possible course failure.

Students are encouraged to seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit and rely on personal study of God's Word, rather than technological shortcuts, to grow in true biblical understanding. As believers, we hold fast to the truth that "*a false balance is abomination to the Lord: but a just weight is his delight*" (**Proverbs 11:1, KJV**).

All assignments, quizzes, and exams at **King James Bible College** are **open-book**. Students are encouraged to take full advantage of this opportunity by reading and studying their Bible as they complete each course.

Our goal is not only academic success, but spiritual growth through consistent engagement with Scripture. By the time students complete all **48 courses** required for the **Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies**, they will have read through the entire Bible.

10. Partner Churches (Hubs)

At **King James Bible College**, we are blessed to partner with local churches across the country who share our commitment to sound biblical teaching and the King James Bible. These churches serve as **Hub Partner Churches**, working alongside us to expand the reach of our ministry and assist students within their regions.

Our **Partner Churches** play a vital role by:

- Assisting in the **grading** of student lessons and the **mailing out** of new coursework to students who reside in the same state or surrounding states.
- **Hosting in-person courses** from time to time. These courses are fully approved and backed by King James Bible College and can earn a certificate towards that particular course being offered.
- **Praying for our students**, supporting ministry needs, and helping strengthen the connection between local churches and biblical education.

Our goal is to establish at least **two Partner Churches in every state**, allowing students to benefit from local support, in-person fellowship, and ministry opportunities. We work closely with each of our partner churches to ensure consistency and excellence in every aspect of biblical training.

Some Partner Churches may also **host graduation ceremonies** for our students, allowing local graduates and their families to celebrate this milestone together.

11. How to Become a Partner Church

Churches interested in partnering with **King James Bible College** are encouraged to contact our college office to discuss partnership opportunities. Partner Churches assist with grading, lesson distribution, prayer support, hosting in-person courses, resources and occasionally graduation ceremonies.

To begin the process, a church may reach out directly to our administrator. Each partnership is prayerfully reviewed to ensure alignment with our mission to uphold the **King James Bible** and provide faithful biblical education.

We welcome churches who share our vision of training students in God's Word and expanding the reach of biblical ministry across the nation and throughout the world.

12. Graduation Information

Graduation ceremonies are a time of celebration and thanksgiving for the work God has done in the lives of our students. All students who complete their program requirements are invited to participate in **any graduation ceremony** hosted by King James Bible College or one of our **Partner Churches**.

A **minimum suggested donation of \$50** per student helps cover the cost of the **cap and gown**, as well as **refreshments** following the ceremony. Please note that housing or travel accommodations are **not provided** by the college or partner churches.

Graduations are generally held **each September**, with a **cut-off date of August 31st** to be included in that year's ceremony. Students who complete all requirements **after September 1st** will be included in the following year's graduation.

All graduation ceremonies are **live streamed online**, and the **names of all graduates** are included in the program, even if they are unable to attend in person.

At King James Bible College, we rejoice with each graduate who has faithfully completed their studies, giving all glory to God for their dedication to His Word and calling in their life.

14. Required Public Notices

1. Exemption Statement:


